CONSTRUCTION:

I. Superstructures

- One piece moulded hull with hand-laminated reinforced fibreglass. Colour: White.
- Boot top, moulded in colour.
- One piece moulded deck with hand-laminated reinforced fibreglass, and includes:
 - raised toe rail.
 - large self-bailing cockpit.
 - two large cockpit side-lockers with safety hasps.
 - moulded non-skid surfaces where necessary.
 Colour: White.
- Moulded forward V-berth with four stowage lockers. Colour: Desert White.
- Moulded starboard quarter-berth with two stowage lockers. Colour: Desert White.
- Moulded port quarter-berth and kitchen counter with:
 - two stowage lockers under berth.
 - stowage locker under counter.
 - moulded kitchen sink.
 - moulded large-sized insulated icebox.
 Colour: Desert White.
- Interior hull liner. Colour: Desert White.
- Interior deck liner. Colour: Desert White.
- Hatches: Forecabin and sliding main hatches, fibreglass. Colour: White.

II. Miscellaneous structures

- Kick up rudder.
- Naval bronze transom fittings.
- Ash tiller.
- Fibreglass extra-reinforced centreboard housing.
- Steel centreboard plate with lead ballasted bulb.
- Cockpit-operated centreboard winch.

RIGGING SPECIFICATIONS:

- Modern masthead rig.
- Aluminum mast and boom, anodised.
- Pivoting mast step.
- Roller reefing.
- Aluminum spreaders.
- Stainless steel chain plates and mast tangs.
- Stainless steel turnbuckles.
- Stainless steel standing rigging, swaged in terminals (includes 1 forestay, 2 upper and 2 lower shrouds, 1 backstay with bridle. All 5/32 S.S. except for bridle).
- Stainless steel halyards with dacron rope tails.
- Aluminum halyard cleats.
- Dacron running rigging.
- Mainsheet swivel block with camcleat, and swivel fiddle block.
- Dacron braided mainsheet.
- Fairleads, pair.
- Snubbing winches for jibsheets, pair.
- Camcleats for jib or genoa sheets.
- Stainless steel bow plate bolted to deck AND hull.
- Boom vang.

EXTERIOR APPOINTMENTS:

- Two fixed front lites (windows).
- Two fixed side lites (windows).
- Teak finished drop door with lock.
- Above constructed with louvres for ventilation, screen to keep off insects, and sliding back panel to keep out rain.
- Bow chocks, pair.
- Bow and stern mooring cleats.
- Two large side seats on deck provide sleeping berths for additional two with over boom awning.

INTERIOR APPOINTMENTS:

- Separate main and fore cabins.
- Access from main cabin to fore cabin.
- Arborite teak panelled bulkheads.
- Four 6'3" sleeping berths (stowage under).
- Wide shoulder room on berths.
- Mahogany trims on all berths.
- Completely separate head compartment.
- Spacious man-sized galley with built-in sink and icebox, with space for stove.
- Large stowage space under cockpit.
- Comfortable sitting headroom.
- Carpeted floor.
- Bilge inspection port.

NOTE: Following is a partial list of items standard on the MATILDA, but options/or not available on most competitive products: Boot top. Sink. Icebox. Interior liners. Forehatch. Kick up rudder. S.S. Swaged terminals. Boom Vang. Front windows. Teak drop door. Bow chocks. Mooring cleats. Separate main and fore cabins. Teak panelled bulkheads. Completely separate head compartment. Carpeting.
